

Reading assignment for May 14-20; Esther 8-10; Job 1-20;

Theme: Victorious

Memory: John 1:21 *"Naked I came from my mother's womb, & naked shall I return there. The LORD gave, & the LORD has taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD."*

Consider/discuss

1. Why was the Feast of Purim established in Esther 9? What possible significance does this Feast have for Christians today?

2. What important truths did God force Satan to admit in Job 1:7, 1:10 and 2:2? How do these truths apply to us?

3. Job 19:25-27 *"For I know that my Redeemer lives, & He shall stand at last on the earth; & after my skin is destroyed, this I know, that in my flesh I shall see God, whom I shall see for myself, & my eyes shall behold, & not another. How my heart yearns within me!"*
