

Reading assignment for July 30 – August 5: Isaiah 6-27

Memory: Isaiah 25:1 *“O LORD, You are my God. I will exalt You, I will praise your name, for you have done wonderful things; your counsels of old are faithfulness and truth.”*

Consider/discuss:

Isaiah 6

- A. What did Isaiah see in verses 1-4?
- B. What problem did Isaiah speak of in verse 5? What was done to solve his problem?
- C. What question did the Lord ask, and what was the response in verse 8?
- D. What assignment God gave to Isaiah in verse 9-10?

Chapter 7

- A. What plans had Syria and Israel made against Judah in verses 5-6?
- B. What assurance did God give Isaiah in verses 7-9?
- C. How can we be comforted by the message God gave Isaiah in 7:7-9?

Chapter 9

- A. Who is predicted in verses 6-7, and what do these verses teach about His role?
- B. Explain the significance of each name used for Him:
 - Wonderful
 - Counselor
 - Mighty God
 - Everlasting Father
 - Prince of Peace

Chapter 11

- A. Describe the characteristics the Holy Spirit would place on Jesus (11:3-5)

Chapter 14

- A. What would cause the downfall of Lucifer (14:12-15)?

Chapter 26

- A. What blessings come to those who trust in God (vv.3-4)?
