

Reading assignment for August 27 – September 2: Jeremiah 31-52; Lamentations 1

Memory: Jeremiah 33:3 *“Call to me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.”*

Consider:

- 1) As we see illustrated in the book of Jeremiah, commitment to God will bring you into direct conflict with people who reject Him and His values. We also see that if you remain faithful to Him, in the end He will exalt you.
- 2) Notice how many times you find the phrase *“the word of the Lord came to Jeremiah”*, even as he endured unimaginable difficulties. What does this say about him?
- 3) Why did God allow the Jews to face judgment at the hands of the Babylonians (see 32:28-35)? What promise did God make in 32:37-44?
- 4) In 33:6-9 God promised great blessings upon the Jewish people. Use these verses as a prayer guide for you and your family.
- 5) Take note in chapters 41-45 of God’s faithfulness to His word by allowing judgment upon unrepentant Judah. Also take note of Jeremiah’s faithfulness to his ministry in the most difficult of circumstances.
