Week 9: Deuteronomy 30-33; Joshua 1-18;

Theme: Possessing God's Promises

Memory: Deuteronomy 31:6 *"Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the LORD your God, He is the one who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you."*

1. Notice the instructions God gave in Deuteronomy 30:16 for His people to love, walk and obey.
  - A. What did these instructions refer to?
  - B. What promises did God give in verses 16 and 17?
  - C. How do these instructions and promises relate to us today?
  
2. Deuteronomy 32:36 *"For the Lord will judge His people and have compassion on His servants, when He sees that their power is gone, and there is no one remaining, bond or free."*
  - A. What does this passage mean to you personally?
  
3. Joshua 1 records the conversation between God and Joshua shortly after Moses' death. What is the most interesting part of that conversation from your perspective?
  
4. What were the keys to the victory at Jericho in Joshua 5-6? What were the keys to the defeat at Ai in Joshua 7? What were the keys to victory at Ai in Joshua 8?
  
5. What was the primary lesson you learned from your reading this week?
