CONSIDER/DISCUSS

- 1) What promise is recorded in Hosea 6:1-3 and how does it apply to us? What must we do to see this promise fulfilled?
- 2) What promise is recorded in Hosea 10:12 and how does it apply to us?
 - A. What is fallow ground and how does it represent the condition of a person's spiritual condition?
 - B. How can a man's spiritual condition become fallow?
 - C. How can a fallow heart become broken? What happens to a man who breaks his fallow heart?
- 3) Describe the condition of the land in Joel 1:12. Beginning in Joel 1:13 the Lord laid out specific plans for the people to respond to their circumstances. What did the Lord require of the people and why did He require these actions?
- 4) What is your answer to the question in Amos 3:3? What is the significance of this question?
