**Memory:** *Nahum 1:7 "The Lord is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble, and he knows those who trust in Him."*

**CONSIDER**

1. What would you say is the theme of the book of Jonah?
2. What does meaningful religion look like according to Micah 6:8?
3. The dominant theme in Micah 7 is sorrow for the sins of the nation, confession of sin and God's mercy extended to the Jewish people. Now does this chapter mirror our own walk with the Lord?
4. Rewrite Habakkuk 3:17-19 in your own words and describe what these verses mean to you.
5. Jonah's ministry in the city of Nineveh produced a city-wide revival marked by humility and repentance. Unfortunately the revival was short lived and the people backslid. The book of Nahum was a rebuke to the people of Nineveh for backsliding. What important principles do we learn from this book?
  - A. What kind of spiritual reform should the people of Nineveh have implemented to prevent the backsliding?
  - B. How does this story apply to our culture today?
