

Reading assignment for October 29 – November 4; Luke 8-24; John 1-6;

Memory: Luke 9:1-2 *"Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases. And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick."*

Consider:

1. Luke 9:10-17, and John 6:1-15
 - A. Describe the details of Jesus feeding the 5,000. Pay attention to the enormity of the need, the location, the organization, the resources used, etc.
 - B. What lessons can you take from this story and apply to your life?
2. What principle did Jesus illustrate with the Parable of the Good Samaritan in Luke 10:25-37?
3. In Luke 17:5 the disciples asked Jesus to increase their faith.
 - A. How did Jesus respond?
 - B. Does faith come naturally or can it be developed?
 - C. Why do we need faith?
4. How did Jesus' mother and the servants demonstrate faith in 2:1-11?
5. Write a theology of salvation based on John 3:15-17, 36.
